

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **Personal Belongings:** Label all of your belongings including clothing, electronics, toiletries, and money. Remember, the camp is not responsible for lost items.
2. **Personal Space:** Respect the personal space of others. Do not go through other people's belongings without permission. There is ZERO tolerance for any form of theft.
3. **Valuables:** To prevent loss or damage, it's best to leave your valuable items at home.
4. **Courtesy:** Treat every member of the camp community with respect and kindness. There is ZERO tolerance for any form of bullying or harassment. Abstain from using any offensive or foul language.
5. **Modest Behavior:** Participants should engage in respectful and modest behavior at all times. Engagement in any romantic activities or behavior during the camp is strictly prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, flirting, intimate physical contact, romantic gestures, or any form of romantic relationships.
6. **Village Rules:** Males are not allowed in the female village and vice versa at any time.
7. **Digital Decorum:** We want to emphasize that using your cell phone inappropriately or for indecent activities undermines the trust, respect, and safety of our community. Inappropriate use includes, but is not limited to, taking or sharing inappropriate images, bullying or harassing others, or any form of dishonest behavior. Such actions will not be tolerated and could result in disciplinary actions, including immediate expulsion from the camp. It's important that we use technology responsibly, respecting the privacy and dignity of ourselves and others at all times.
8. **Modest Dressing:** Maintain modesty in your dressing at all times. Avoid clothing with suggestive logos or artwork. If your clothing is deemed inappropriate, you may be asked to change.
 - **Boys:** Refrain from wearing cut-off shirts or tight clothing in common areas.
 - **Girls:** Ensure your outfits are modest, especially in common areas. Tops and bottoms should be loose and cover your body appropriately. No skinny jeans or leggings. Hijab is mandatory outside of the girls village.
9. **Prohibited Substances:** The possession or use of tobacco products, vapes, alcohol, or illegal drugs is strictly prohibited. Violation will result in immediate expulsion at your own expense.
10. **Medication:** If you require prescription medication, please label it properly and hand it to the staff medical coordinator for administration.
11. **Safety:** Once you arrive please DO NOT leave the premises until you check out at the Welcome Center, unless given permission from a member of the admin team
12. **Cleanliness:** Help maintain a clean and respectful environment in the camp. Campers are expected to clean up after themselves daily.
13. **Littering:** Do not litter. Make sure you dispose of all waste in designated bins.
14. **Mandatory Attendance:** Your punctual presence is required at all functions, including prayers, educational programs, meals, and activities.
15. **Staff Supervision:** Campers are NOT allowed to be in the cabin areas during programs without any counselors present.
16. **Prayer Hall Etiquette:** Enter the prayer hall through designated entrances only. Place your shoes on the rack before entering. Please dress appropriately.
17. **Activity Restrictions:** Use of the lake, sports facilities, and other activities is only permitted during specified times and under staff supervision.
18. **Activity Equipment:** After use, return all activity equipment to their designated places. Any damage to equipment may result in replacement charges.
19. **Lights Out:** Respect the 'lights out' rule to ensure everyone gets adequate rest.
